Elisha Project Dress Code Expectations



Purpose / Mission:

1. Experience God (Connecting with God)
2. Develop Friendships (Connecting with Others)
3. Discover Purpose (Connecting with Purpose)

Ladies:

1. Hair neatly groomed and out of the face. Natural in color (No dyed or punk rock styles).
2. Shirts must have a sleeve (approximately to the middle of the arm or longer), no low necklines (2 finger rule), or revealing the back or stomach.
3. Skirts or dresses must be below the knee with modest slits below the knee. (Dressy Jean Skirts are acceptable on Thursdays – not on Sundays or during Elisha Project Classes). Pants / Shorts are not acceptable at any time. No Denim.
4. No makeup or Jewelry (Wedding Rings & Watches are the exception).
5. Flip-flops or casual sandals are not permitted.

Men:

1. Hair neatly groomed, out of the face and off the collar. Natural in color (No dyed or punk rock styles).
2. Shirts & Ties required (suit jackets are preferred).
3. Long Pants or slacks that are neat in appearance (Dressy Jeans are acceptable on Thursday, Not on Sundays or Elisha Project Classes). No Denim.
4. No Jewelry (Wedding Rings & Watches are the exception).
5. Flip-flops or casual sandals are not permitted on the platform.

Remember:

The purpose of attending the Elisha Project is to become the minister God has called you to be. You should always present yourself in a way that would bring Glory to God and encourage others to see Christ through you. Adhering to the Dress Code Policy Expectations will allow the attention to be on God, learning, and skill development and not on the individual person.
